PARTICIPANTS

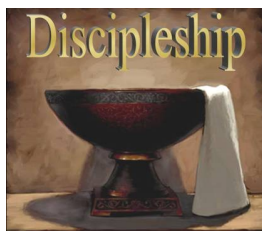
All adults wanting a deeper appreciation and knowledge of the Catholic faith, a deeper relationship with God, a greater self awareness for their on-going personal and spiritual development, and a desire to apply their faith to daily life.

REQUIREMENTS

There are **two major components** for completion of the Specialization in Discipleship: foundational theological courses and participation in a spiritual formation group.

DATES

The concentration is offered from mid Sept through early June. Classes are suspended 4 weeks for Christmas and New Year holidays and one week for Thanksgiving, Holy Week, and Derby Week. Both evening and daytime sessions are available.



Foundational Classes

Each 2.5 hour class (CC) is offered in both the evening and daytime. Skills Workshops (CW) are offered on certain Saturdays from 9-3.
